The purpose of the NJ Qualifying Match is to give New Jersey 4-H'ers (14 years old by January 1, 2011, and older) a chance to qualify to be a member of the NJ State Archery Team. The Team will attend the National 4-H Shooting Sports 2011 Invitational from June 19–24 in Kerrville, Texas. This event is solely an individual competition. The Archery event consists of 2 disciplines with 3 events in each:

**Archery Compound (including Mathews Genesis Bow): Field Round, FITA Round, and 3-D Round**

**Archery Recurve: FITA Round, Field Round, and 3-D Round**

**Match and/or Range Officials may dismiss or disqualify a participant if it is believed that the participant does not demonstrate the basic proficiency and knowledge required for the discipline.**

**NOTE: Please bring your own picnic lunch and refreshments.**

**(There are no food concession stands on the premises.)**

Garden State Parkway South to Exit 130  
US 1 toward Trenton 6.3 miles  
Slight right, then left turn onto Sand Hills Road  
Sand Hills Road becomes Major Road

***From South:***

US 1 North  
Turn right onto Major Road, (which is less than 1 mile  
past Greenview Road and New Road.)
